ENVIRONMENTAL COMMITMENT

To combat climate change, we are delivering a range of measures to better our environmental obligations. We are fully committed to meeting and exceeding regulatory changes for a sustainable future.

Trailblazing activities include the work of the RO Energy division which is delivering a 20-acre 5MW solar park at Potash Farm in Buckinghamshire. This renewable energy project should create enough electricity for more than 1,800 homes and a reduction of more than 2,300 tonnes of carbon emissions annually.

We actively promote recycling at our headquarters office in Fair Oak and across our development portfolio and are committed to reducing waste generation.

Our developments support sustainable travel, with walking and cycling routes

and access to public transport a key characteristic.

We seek to deliver biodiversity net gains at each new development. Proactive ecological enhancements include tree and shrub planting, green infrastructure, nesting boxes, bat boxes, and habitats for local reptiles. We include above ground sustainable urban drainage features, with an emphasis upon wet features, where possible, to provide both sustainable drainage but also additional wildlife and biodiversity benefits. We continually review our design code principles to positively influence and engage with the policy makers and local stakeholders.
